7. Supplemental Recruitment Measures:

a. Participation in Job Fairs – *(i) Participation in at least four job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions.*

- Veterans' Outreach Center Job Fair (10/13/09) – SMG Rochester donated air time and participated in the Veterans' Outreach Job Fair in Rochester. The Sales Manager was on hand to discuss employment opportunities with job seekers and distribute literature.
- State University at Geneseo (3/25/09) The Sales Manager and Marketing Director attended a job fair at SUNY Geneseo
- State University at Brockport (11/4/09) The Sales Manager and Promotions Director attended a job fair at SUNY Brockport

- b. Internship Program - *(v) Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.*

SMG has an internship program for students and members of the community to help them acquire skills needed for employment in the broadcast industry. The programs operate all year long and are offered in programming, promotions, marketing and sales. SMG sends out internship packages to 11 schools in Western and Central New York.

- c. Sponsorship of community events to inform the public of careers in broadcasting – *(x) Participation in at least four events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to career opportunities in broadcasting*

- Students from City of Rochester Schools (9/17/09) – WRMM personality gave a tour of the SMG facilities and talked about how radio stations operate and the different jobs in the radio broadcasting industry.
- Greece Olympia High School Students (10/21/09) – WFKL Morning Show host gave a tour of the station facilities and educated the group on different jobs in the radio industry.
- Girl Scout Troops (11/11/09) WRMM personality gave a tour of the SMG facilities to two different troops and talked about jobs in the broadcast industry.
- Boy Scout Troops (12/28/09) WRMM personality gave a tour of the SMG facilities and talked about jobs in the broadcast industry.

- d. Meeting with Community Organizations about opportunities in broadcasting – *(xv) Provision of training to the personnel of unaffiliated non-profit organizations interested in broadcast employment opportunities that would enable them to better refer job candidate for broadcast positions.*

The general manager has discussed job opportunities with executives at the Veterans Outreach Center and ARC of Monroe County to educate them regarding the variety of job possibilities in broadcasting. The goal was to help the organizations better refer job candidates to the stations for jobs they may not have been aware of.
